



DUCHESNE COUNTY SURVEY MONUMENT RECORD

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND:

The original G.L.O. pipe with brass cap monument was found at this corner. The pipe had rusted and broken off. That portion of the pipe that had been set below the ground surface was still in place. A Duchesne County aluminum monument was driven down over the existing pipe. The broken off
