### Library statistics/Budget questions:

- the wifi has been used a lot in Duchesne
- high amount of transfers from Uintah
  - Greg Todd We should all go to the Unitah County Library to take a tour to see what we want or don't want for the new facility in Roosevelt
- Events Duchesne Branch is approaching 2000 total people attending events.
  - o 290 people at the closing reading party for Roosevelt.
  - 140 people at the Harry Potter party in Roosevelt.
  - 1200 signed up for summer reading for both libraries combined. About 1/3 finished from each library.
- Budget 66% increase in summer incentives

# **Circulation Policy Possible Changes to New Accounts:**

# Proposed 2018 budget:

- Reviewed the budgeting Worksheet
  - $\circ$  may need to raise the advertising from \$1000 to \$5000
  - expenses can go down \$1000 each
  - equipment and supplies raised from \$3000 to \$10,000
  - programming increased from \$15,000 to \$20,000
  - transportation/outreach down from \$11500 to \$6000
  - capital outlay cutting from \$50,000 to \$10,000
  - the total budget is down \$35,500 from 2017
  - Possible new position Daniel/Duchesne branch needs someone to take care of programming (party planning and educational planning) at the Duchesne branch and push out advertising for about 23 hours a week for about \$12 an hour.
