FALL Cleaning and Burning

The window for fall cleaning and burning in Duchesne County will be From Sept. 15 through Oct. 31, 2016. All controlled burns must be reported to Central dispatch @ 789-4222 or 738-2424. No household refuse can be burned and burn barrels are illegal. A burn permit is required.

Agricultural burning is from November 1, 2016 through May 31, 2017 no burn permit is required, must be outside incorporated city limits to qualify as agricultural. Again all controlled burns must be reported to central dispatch.

June 1 through October 31, 2017 is CLOSED FIRE SEASON; a burn permit is required. Only agricultural burning is allowed, no yard clean up burning outside of the spring and fall burn windows is allowed. Burn permit can be obtained by calling Duchesne County Fire @ 738-1181 or the Duchesne County Fire Warden @ 435-790-4741.

Burning instructions:

1. Refuse should be in clear area away from any structure that may catch fire.
2. Refuse should be in a clear area away from any trees that may catch fire.
3. Burn area should not be under or by power poles , power lines, or any other utility services.
4. Always have a good water source available while burning.
5. Watch and tend the fire at all time
- 6. Central Dispatch must be notified when you are burning @ 789-4222**
- 7. You are liable if the fire escapes the control area.**
8. The fire must be out by dusk.
9. Any piles larger than 4 X 5 feet and greater than 3 feet in the height can not be burned without previous inspection.
10. Burn during daylight hours and no wind condition.
