New 3D Printer Acquired with Grant at Duchesne Branch

Duchesne Branch's 3D printer had been having problems with various printing components and became inoperable despite efforts to repair it. Over the last year Daniel had debated upgrading the printer to allow for greatly improved features. It was decided to purchase an upgraded printer rather than try to professionally repair the old one and use the Community Library Enhancement Fund grant to purchase it.

The new printer is the Ultimaker S3. New features include: 2 print heads which allows for more technical and delicate prints, the ability to use a wider variety of printing materials, a front door providing greater safety, and other automatic features that simplified the printing process.
